Note: MAT will be common to all classes whereas SAT will be different.

SYLLABUS FOR COLLEGES

(JUNIOR AND SENIOR/DEGREE)

- Quantitative Analysis
- Data Interpretation and Logical Reasoning
- Vocabulary and Reading Comprehension
- Current Affairs
- General Knowledge

Note: Junior college (+2, intermediate) and Senior/Degree College (degree; first four years) students will answer different questions.

- **Register** for NTS by filling the Student's Registration tab

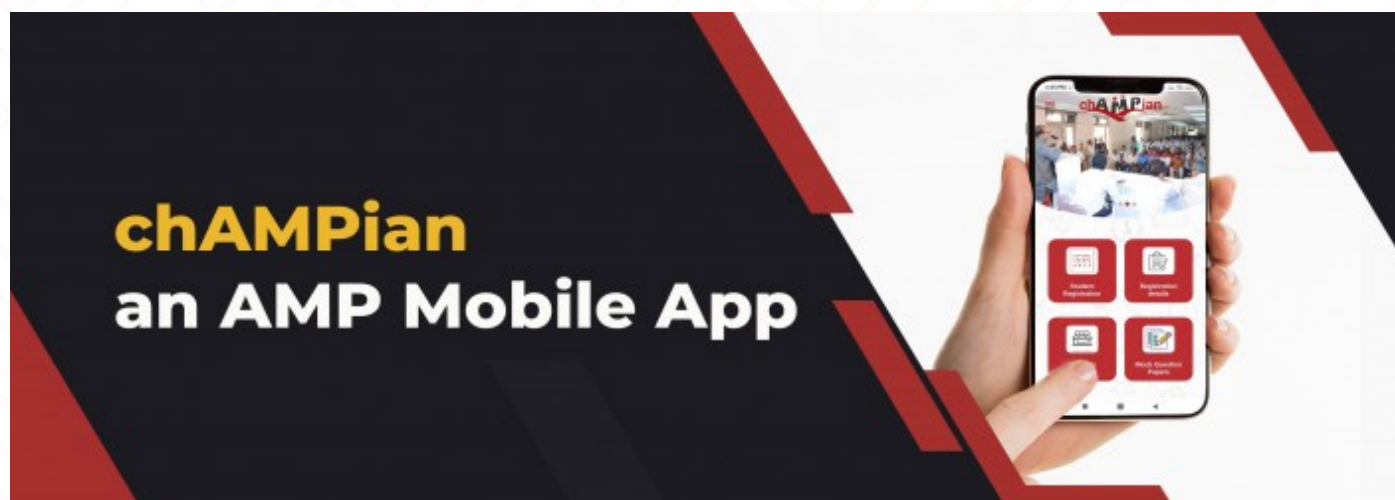
EXAM MODE
